Tips & Tricks for Valentine's Day



Valentine's Day -February 13 & 14

We will celebrate Valentine's Day on February 13 and 14 with a valentine exchange. We will have mailbags for children to bring home at the end of the day. Children are welcome to bring valentines to school, and valentines will be placed in the individual mailbags. Afterwards the children will be given class time to look at their valentines before bringing them home. Occasionally valentines may include treats, and these will be saved to be enjoyed at home rather than at school. At drop off, it would be greatly appreciated if parents/caregivers could stay and assist your child to distribute the valentines into the mailbags.

Writing valentines is an excellent opportunity for children to practice writing their names, especially for our older students who are getting ready for kindergarten. For quick distribution of valentines only write who the valentines are from. For a challenge, write who the valentines are for as well who they are from (depends on your time and patience). Please see your classroom teacher if you would like a list of classmates' first names.
